

Crieff Community Trust Board Meeting Minutes

The regular monthly meeting of the Crieff Community Trust ("CCT") board was held on Thursday 15th May 2014 at Coneyhill, Carrington Terrace, Crieff. The meeting started at 7:30pm, led by the Chair, Ailsa Campbell. The minutes of the previous meeting had been reviewed prior to the meeting and were accepted by all after agreed amendments and modifications. Apologies were received from Ruth Stone.

1. Matters arising from previous meeting

- Roger has contacted the Transport Group, ongoing activity.
- EH to raise Living Streets request to meet at CUSP meeting on June 16th
- Invite Investing in Ideas to be contacted to investigate funding for Paths Group
- Preliminary study on Drummond Arms update due in May
- All groups to confirm if want to make use of visit funding
- Organization and overview sent to GD, AS, PK, RB, MR
- Finalize project tracking document & send to project team with timeline overview to request updates on going
- EH to finalize updates to Funding Policy and publish
- Draft Welcome Pack provided to Ailsa for review

2. Admission of new member

3 new members; 2 full members and 1 associate member, taking the total membership to 453, of which 361 are full members.

3. Treasurer report

Very few transactions in the last month. The money available for site visits and training should be used by end of June. DG proposed visit to Neilston nr Paisley, who have renovated a derelict building. AC to discuss with TC Group.

AR provided an update on the Bingo Tea, which was a very successful night. The event raised a total of £732.60; £318.50 from Raffle and £414.10 from Bingo. Hire of hall still to be paid to the British Legion. AC agreed to contact Rhona Brock.



4. AGM debrief

New Board Member, Roger Brickell was introduced. Since the AGM, Alastair Strickland has contacted CCT and stipulated 3 conditions before committing to joining the CCT Board. CCT are unable to accept these conditions. HG to contact Alastair Strickland to discuss.

Co-opted Board Members

AC invited Graham Donaldson to become a co-opted Board Member. GD expressed that his area of expertise so far had not been called for and expressed reservations on joining if there was no opportunity to contribute.

AC indicated that whilst the Drummond Arms was a long term ongoing project, the trust would benefit from premises on the high street which could be shared with other community groups. And that GD, with his experience could help the trust with this project.

GD agreed to look at the possibility of a high street premises and come on board but would like to see something move on the property front.

AC invited Mhairi Rolin to become a co-opted Board Member. MR agreed and would contribute more once up to speed on the different projects. EH believes that MR could provide support the board in getting better communication with the project teams. HG to contact GD and MR so we can submit new director information to Company house, within the next 2 weeks.

What went well, what did not go well, what would we do differently: MR believed that the AGM went well. The presentation was a good idea, giving the attendees something to follow and was well delivered. All agreed and thanked Ailsa Campbell for a great job at the AGM. GD agreed the numbers were good but disappointing no one volunteered to come on board.



5. Project Status Updates

Town Centre: decisions required on the following areas

- Heritage Lottery Project Enquiry Form
 - This was circulated by Ruth before she left on May 6
 - feasibility study as part of Phase One. Or if the assumption is that Phase 1 would be the study completed by Fergus. DG confirmed that Investing Ideas would not be contacted by RS for the Drummond Arms.
 - EH confirmed that the purpose was to submit a project enquiry, which would then allow CCT to discuss next steps for a feasibility project and subsequent business case.
 - EH to check Barry/Ruth has comments from Mhairi, which were sent through last week.
- Date to review CRTB & Preliminary Feasibility Study
 EH to send options for meetings before the next board meeting.

Paths Group

DG confirmed that the survey had officially closed on May 15

feedback received the following day would be included. The survey had received 1200+ responses, and preliminary results were encouraging and supportive.

Next steps are to write the final report and circulate to the Board & PKC. An early copy will be sent to the land owners and community council plus our local members of parliament before publishing.

DG confirmed Guy Wedderburn has met with the landowners to understand their concerns and further meetings will be held to address these.

DG advised that the group would like to contact Investing in Ideas, The Climate challenge Fund and The Gannochy Trust to seek funding for the path feasibility study. GD mentioned that the Robertson Trust may support this, DG to look into this.

Marketing Group

EH confirmed the group were finalizing their presentation and requested to present at the board meeting in June. Meeting agreed.

EH waiting for confirmation from John Champion if funding to update Crieff.org has been received.

Community & Recreation

AR confirmed that the Junior football club continues to work on a sports hub and AR is still in contact and supporting.

Transport

RB has contacted the group and confirmed that we need more people to get involved. It was thought that Robert MacFarlane may be able to provide input into the town bus services and DG suggested he talk to Andrew Donaldson about the Ring of Breadalbane Explorer bus service.

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6. CCC & CUSP updates

CCC: AC confirmed that Alan Rankin had been appointed as the BID project leader. And that the BID group are planning to support the Science Festivals for Schools, planned for February 2015 run by Stuart Cuthbert.

AC confirmed the banners for town for the Ryder are on order. No CUSP meeting in May. The AGM is on 19 Brickell will attend.
