



TOWN CENTRE

- Participating in Scotland Can Do Towns project June ongoing
- Community Right To Buy (22%) granted October
- Site visit to Barony Centre, West Kilbride, attended Scotland's Community Heritage Conference November
- RBS sells to Strathfare ending court case,
 met with RBS & Sohan Singh/Strathfare November
- Strathfare not selling, watching brief, look at other derelict sites
- Participated in Charette, waiting for report
- Applied unsuccessfully for DTAS Community Led Town Centre Fund
- Promised £5000 from DTAS

- Learn outcome from charette and act on it
- Write proposal to DTAS about plans for money
- Speak at Can Do Town event 'Local v Global' on 3rd June about community activism/volunteering challenges



COMMUNITY & RECREATIONAL FACILITIES


- Met with Head Teacher, Campus Manager & Librarian

ACCESS TO SERVICES & TRANSPORT




- Revised route and timetable for Crieff Town Bus started in January
- Created Strathallan Community Rail Partnership Steering Group
- ScotRail submitting the application for the Strathallan Operating Rail Partnership on CRP's behalf






- Review new Town Bus service
- Work with PKC and local communities for a half-hourly timetable of Service 15 to Perth
- Form Strathallan CRP Board to work towards improved service at Gleneagles train station



MARKETING & PROMOTION

- Group working on plans to consult with community and groups on a logo for Crieff
- Awaiting outcome of BID vote to finalise next steps
- Worked with CUSP to improve crieff.org now live
- Supported CUSP with Phase 1 release of Crieff.org: new design and improved security

- Further development and maintenance of Crieff.org
- Promote Crieff.org over the coming months











ENVIRONMENT & HERITAGE (PATHS)

- Funding received from the Gannochy Trust & Scottish Natural Heritage [matching PKC Sustrans grant] received to carry out survey and feasibility study for Crieff to Comrie core path [Trowan – Comrie]
- Negotiations with landowners for Crieff to Comrie path are ongoing
- Grants of £22,000 for Acorn Dell repair received from SSE and PKC
- Several path improvement work days held

- Phase 1 of Acorn Dell path repair
- Seeking funding to develop a management plan for Acorn Dell
- Trowan to Comrie: next stages depend on negotiations with landowners – watch this space!
