

Objects of the Crieff Community Trust

March 2012

1. To advance community development through the promotion of trade and industry within the Crieff area for the benefit of the general public.
 - To engage with PKC to develop guidance for local shop owners in relation to developing and maintaining shop fronts in accordance with Crieff's Conservation Area status.
 - Create a Crieff loyalty card to encourage spending in the town.
 - Provide business support through workshops.
2. To advance the health and wellbeing of the residents of the Crieff area.
 - Work with other local communities to develop joined-up cycle / foot paths between Muthill and Crieff and between Comrie and Crieff.
 - Develop a shared garden scheme.
 - Expand the provision of bicycle racks at key points in the town.
3. To advance education and in particular to promote opportunities for learning for the benefit of the general public.
 - Provide learning opportunities to help residents and community groups contribute to reducing Crieff's carbon footprint.
4. To advance the arts and/or culture.
 - Develop a derelict building for flexible space for community arts and crafts workshops / courses / exhibitions / cinema / live performances etc.
5. Providing, or assisting in providing, recreational facilities, and/or organising recreational activities, which will be available to members of the Community and public at large or those who by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disability, poverty or social and economic circumstances have need for those facilities and activities with the object of improving conditions of life of the Community.
 - Work with other local communities to develop joined-up cycle/foot paths between Muthill and Crieff and between Comrie and Crieff.
 - Investigate developing derelict buildings for flexible use of space for community arts and crafts workshops / courses / exhibitions / cinema / live performances etc.
 - Work with other local groups / youth clubs to improve social provision for children / young people in Crieff.
6. To advance citizenship and/or community development (including the promotion of civic responsibility and the promotion of the voluntary sector and/or the effectiveness or efficiency of charities).
 - Engage and involve the wider community and community groups in plans for town improvements through a Community Action Plan.
 - Develop and support a community website / app – online blog / community calendar.
 - Develop a skills database and encourage a skills swap – advertised on community website.

7. To encourage, stimulate and support volunteering principally in the Crieff area.
 - Clean up disused land in the town.
 - Provide ad hoc emergency support for older people in the community.
8. To advance environmental protection and improvement in the Crieff area through the provision, maintenance and/or improvement of public open space and other public amenities and other environmental and regeneration projects (but subject to appropriate safeguards to ensure that the public benefits so arising clearly outweigh any private benefit thereby conferred on private landowners).
 - Develop a carbon reduction strategy for Crieff.
 - Expand provision of bike racks through the town.
 - Clean up disused land in the town.
 - Develop a shared garden scheme.
9. To advance heritage and/or preserve, for the benefit of the general public, the historical, architectural and constructional heritage that may exist in and around the Crieff area in buildings (including any structure or erection, and any part of a building as so defined) of particular beauty or historical, architectural or constructional interest.
 - To engage with PKC to develop guidance for local shop owners in relation to developing and maintaining shop fronts in accordance with Crieff's Conservation Area status.
 - To consult with the Community Council about the design and enforcement of civic standards.
 - To investigate feasibility of developing derelict buildings in the centre of town for the benefit of the community.
