
- Watching brief give owner chance to do something

- Raising the Drummond's profile nationally at Can Do Places events
- Looking for a place to trial a work hub [part of the plan for the Drummond]

2016

- Renewed focus on regenerating the Drummond Arms
- Spoken with John Swinney about Drummond Arms as part of Can Do Places
- Building a team of government, PKC and experts to tackle the Drummond Arms
- Testing a work hub: determine need, research, costs, apply for grants

Next Steps

- Comment on Part 3a tell our story
- Apply for money for a Stage 1 Pre-development Study for Drummond Arms
- Negotiate with Strathfare
- Apply to Big Lottery and LEADER for grants to trial work hub and employ a development worker in the old refectory
- Continue to be part of the Can Do Places framework




ACCESS TO SERVICES & TRANSPORT

ENVIRONMENT & HERITAGE (PATHS)

- Improvements to first part of Lady Mary's Walk through Acorn Dell complete
- Finalising transfer of title of Acorn Dell from CCI to CCT
- 3 proposed routes investigated to link first part of Lady Mary's with rest of path
- Negotiations with landowners for Trowan to Comrie path ongoing
- Several path improvement work days held and continue to happen monthly

Next Steps

- Waiting for technical report and costs for linking of Lady Mary's
- In discussions about developing a woodland management plan for Acorn Dell
- Continue negotiations with landowners with the aim of finalising path agreements
- Continue with path improvement days see CCT website and Facebook page for future dates
